Certified HERS raters are qualified to:

- Perform duct tightness and blower door testing for homebuilders.
- Certify projects for the ENERGY STAR program (after also completing the Energy Star Certified Homes Program).
- Rate new homes in all states (except CA)
- Assist homeowners with problems such as ice dams, moisture, and mold

Both online and classroom components are required for rater certification.

Final registration deadline is August 29, 2022.
