TRAINING COMMITTEE (Joe)

- PSD contract for 2024 needed before October 31 so we can complete our RESNET Training Provider Renewal
 - o Cindy said they will expedite the process.
- Fall 2023 Training
 - o 18 Full Registrations- class is running now.
 - o 4 left on waitlist
 - o Class is through the 2 weeks class,
 - o Issued an RFP for the 4 remaining students on waitlist to attend a training with Sharla (online course) but have PSD assist for the field components not included. No numbers yet from PSD.
- Stretch Code HERS 42 Course Development
 - Will deliver the series: Bumping back to November. Slide deck looks good, but we are looking for feedback on where we should be publicizing the series.
 - November 30: Session I
 - December 7: Session II
 - December 14: Session III
 - December 21: Session IV
 - Applying for AIA, CSL, and RESNET Credits.
 - Welcome ideas for where to publicize.
 - May turn into ongoing series for case studies.
 - Free to members, pay for quiz.
 - Non-members \$25 each and 4 for \$75.
 - Pay Nick's non-profit and H4H thank you fee for \$200. Part of the proceeds support 3 non-profits. Investigate this:
 - Revenue sharing for quizzes and videos. Find a way to keep track of how much money we are getting for the videos and split it into 3 ways to give to nonprofits. Logistical and administrative
- Grant: MassCEC: Equity Workforce Planning and Capacity Grants
 - o The original grant was essentially a 5-year plan which can be a multimillion-dollar project.
 - o So, we removed everything related to the Technical Director position, including curriculum development, until we had secured 3 years of funding.
 - This role will be removed from this grant and put into the request for implementation funding in (end of November.)
 - Left in the Equity Workforce Development Grant is Brenda Building out the wraparound support services for a pilot project. In April of 2024, we will run five students through a pilot using Sharla's prerecorded, RFI or HERS modeler training modules, depending on what the student wants, if they want to be a modeler or RFI.
 - O Brenda is setting up the job placement piece, and job readiness training, and case management, at the beginning how we evaluate candidates, all of that is going to get set up under the grant.
 - Trial that with a pilot project from April to June and will follow up with a job placement process.

- o RFPS for Manual and Curriculum Development
 - RFP Policies and Procedures Document
 - Send RFPs to members only, selected candidates, or our whole network?
 - We have had significant conversations with Sharla Reid about the cost of someone working on the manual.
 - The number came back at \$90,000 for a fully revised manual. In contrast to what it cost last time, 10 years ago it was \$30,000. We have about 3,000 dollars left in manual reserve fund.
 - Brenda recommends we send out an RFP for manual revision.
 - Thoughts?
 - Send out an RFP to our entire network.
 - Score the RFP the Training committee will score the RFPs?
 - O Yes, keep it in just edit 'shall' to 'may'.
